MEET OUR PROJECT

STAND UP - Fighting cyberbullying by identifying it in the VET classroom is an Erasmus+ project, which aims to provide VET teachers with tools to help them understand cyberbullying and how to fight it; In addition, it aims to help VET students become aware of the danger of cyberbullying.

STAND UP brings together organizations from 4 different countries - Acción Laboral (ES), INNOHUB (ES), CWEP (PL), DIAS VET (GR), and Eurospeak Ltd (IE).



PROJECT OBJECTIVES

STAND UP will:

- Provide VET teachers, educators, and professionals, with tools that will enable them to understand the process of cyberbullying, recognize signs in the classroom of possible victims, and understand how they can collaborate in their fight against it.
- Give VET educators tools that will enable them to provide their students with the knowledge they need to understand cyberbullying and its consequences.
- Provide educators with tools and skills to assist their students in case of risk of cyberbullying.
- Create tools that support social inclusion inside and outside the classroom and encourage the creation of a positive school environment in VET classrooms.
- Support the use of an innovative and digital approach to support pedagogical change in VET.
- Provide trainers and students with tools to respond to cyberbullying, now that COVID-19 has led to an increase in cases
- Support the continuing education of VET educators.
- Promote the creation of VET classes in which tolerance and a positive work environment are ensured.

EXPECTED RESULTS

- 1. Training Curriculum for VET teachers:** designed for VET educators, explaining how to detect and manage cyberbullying in the VET classroom.
- 2. Training tools for VET students:** Dynamic and visual content for VET showing them how to behave and react in case they are victims or witnesses of cyberbullying cases.
- 3. Mobile Application:** mobile application in which the results of the project will be available to users, also becoming a place to search for contact information in case of cyberbullying at a local, national and European levels.
