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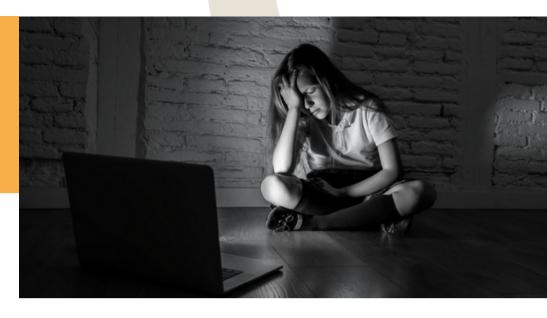
AIM

OBJECTIVES

- To equip VET educators, professionals, and teachers with the knowledge and skills necessary to comprehend cyberbullying, identify potential victims in the classroom, and work together to combat it.
- To give VET instructors the resources they need to impart to their students the understanding of cyberbullying and its repercussions.
- To give teachers the knowledge and abilities they need to help children who could be at risk for cyberbullying or who may already be experiencing it.
- To enhance social inclusion both within and outside of the classroom and foster the development of a healthy school climate in VET classrooms.
- To encourage the adoption of digital strategy to aid in pedagogical reform in VET.
- Given that COVID-19 has increased incidences of cyberbullying, give instructors and students resources to respond to it.
- To encourage VET educators to pursue ongoing education.
- To encourage the development of VET programs that promote tolerance and a supportive learning environment for both the students and the instructors.
